

Answer of civil suit summons:

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Answer of James Bellar and Dove Outreach in Civil Action filed in United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio.

I. Introduction

My name is Min. James R. Bellar. As Founder and Statutory Agent of Dove Outreach Inc. a non-profit Christian Ministry registered with the state of Ohio since 1986; I will be answering these complaints of Jane Doe (A.K.A. Serah Bellar) against myself (James Bellar) and Dove Outreach. The church is but one of the outreaches in my ministry (Dove Outreach). We also have had evangelistic services (other churches, streets, nursing homes, jails and such like), an Internet outreach, newsletters, tracts, and many other outreaches to not belabor the point. So first let me state that these allegations are lies; as we have never taught nor stood for such false, grievous doctrines: and I believe this case against us should be dropped as a frivolous lawsuit.

II. Answers to specific sections of complaint

A. IV FACTS

1. a) Line 11 states that Dove Outreach Church is “cult-like”. A church cannot be cult-like. It is either a (false religious) cult or it is not. I have ministered to many false religious cult members, gang members, and organizations. These bad groups often pretend themselves family-like, but they are not families. As a Christian I am Christ-like, but I am not Jesus Christ.

b) I have NEVER preached that “siblings are meant to procreate with one another.”. I am sent to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ and would never deny what I have preached. Instead, I take this opportunity to affirm that all I have preached is the truth.

2. a) Line 12 Again I can only answer for myself for certain, but here it seems that they are saying that I (James Bellar) and the church Dove Outreach are the foundation to Serah’s alleged abuse. As I know these things to be false it makes the whole case suspect.

b) I have never covered up an abuse

3. Line 13 - Again I have never taught that siblings are to procreate. However if Robert and Deborah were holding to church teaching as this accusation states: why would the plaintiff’s abuse be at ages 5-12? If the teaching is procreation, That word means to have sexual relations with the intent of producing children. There have been no children born to these siblings. Nor any other siblings of the church as we don’t hold that view. Our stand on that teaching is that it is sin. And we bring this up to point out that liars testimony often contradict themselves.

B. V LEGAL CLAIMS

1. Third Claim for Relief

a) lines 64&65 - False: Dove Outreach Church does not facilitate sexual contact with minor children.

b) line 66 - Lie, there are neither fees charged, nor such an ideology.

c) line 67 - False: there was no promotion, nor compulsion to such abuse. And I (James Bellar) have never preached such garbage. I will also state that any church who teaches such wickedness is false.

d) line 68 - There were no such acts committed. We agree if such acts were committed they should be punished. Also, as stated, I believe this would be unlawful conduct. But neither I (James Bellar) nor Dove Outreach has been accused or approached by law enforcement of any kind. Though I have read such similar salacious smears coming from the Athens County Prosecutors office pertaining to the Robert and Deborah Bellar lawsuit; they have not once even talked to me on such matters. Except they did come to my house concerning Robert’s phone once, but nothing about my teaching or the church.

e) line 69 - I (James Bellar) have received no charges of unlawful activity. I have been a resident of Pike county for over 37 years (since December 1984) and my wife Jeanie for all her life. We do not have a reputation as evil doers.

2. Fifth Claim for Relief

a) These accusations are false concerning James Bellar and Dove Outreach: if the plaintiff suffers it is certainly not by us.

3. Sixth Claim for Relief

a) Our (James Bellar, Dove Outreach) love and care for Serah (plaintiff) as well as all the children has been and remains steadfast & perfect unto the glory of God our heavenly Father in

Jesus' name.

4. Ninth Claim for Relief

a) lines 102 & 104 How much farther can this go? They accuse us of pimping out our children. I am reminded of a quote, "If you tell a lie big enough and keep repeating it, people will eventually come to believe it. The lie can be maintained only for such time as the State can shield the people from the political, economic and/or military consequences of the lie."- Joseph Goebbels. This indeed is a frivolous case filled with malicious and salacious slanders meant to cause people to turn away from the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The case should be thrown out and if the Court can say anything it should be done.

5. Tenth Claim for Relief

a) Same as last claim. And there was (is) no such "venture with Dove Outreach Church" and the other defendants.

6. Eleventh Claim for Relief

a) line 117

1) We (James Bellar, Dove Outreach) have never obstructed , but have sought to help and be of service to those in need. Also Serah never came to me (James Bellar) or my wife Jeanie, who had been her Sunday School teacher in the past to complain of any abuse in her household.

2) Not sure what "threatening athletes" means, unless it is a typo or the section is copy pasted from another case? At any rate this did not happen, we (James Bellar, Dove Outreach) never feed false information to investigators.

7. Twelfth Claim for Relief

a) There is no "Bellar Enterprise" of illegality comprising of the defendants. I (James Bellar) do not even know Jimmy Childs. And though I have met many people I have no recollection of ever meeting him.

8. Thirteenth Claim for Relief

a) again there is no enterprise of Dove Outreach or mine (James Bellar) of sexual deviance or misconduct with our or any other children. All such allegations are false.

III. In Summary

I (James Bellar, Dove Outreach) therefore reason that after hearing the truth of these matters; the lawyer Michael L. Fradin may drop this case 2:22-cv- 855 finding out he has been lied to. And if not, the Court may dismiss this case as frivolous and unjustified. It is a sad thing that the law can be used for such purposes and manipulated in this way. And though it is made obvious to me that the accusers (both prosecutorial and attorneys) need to do their homework better; let us work together to make things better.
